About the Course:

The Richmond Chapter of the American Institute of Architects is pleased to offer the Architectural Registration Exam (ARE) Seminar for Mechanical and Electrical Systems. This course provides an overview of mechanical, plumbing and electrical technology topics, offering the opportunity to learn from a professional and use that knowledge in preparation for taking the multiple choice portion of the Building Systems section of the ARE. The course will consist of three, three-hour sessions, for a total of 9 hours of instruction.

About the Instructors:

Jim Fuller will spend one week concentrating on the mechanical issues, including basic thermal processes and basic HVAC equipment. Tina Capece will cover plumbing systems, including basic water supply and drainage systems, along with fire protection. Malcolm Lyle will present the electrical issues, including basic lighting and communication systems.

Cost:

The course fee is \$45 per student. AIA Richmond Associate members will receive a discounted rate of \$15 per student.

Instructor will provide some study materials. Participants are encouraged to bring all necessary items for taking notes and doing basic calculations.

Location:

Sessions will be held in the main conference room of each respective office.

Accommodations and travel are the responsibility of the participant.

Intern Architects - This course prepares participants for successful completion of the mechanical & electrical division of the ARE.
