### **Intern Programs: Hard Hat Tours**

#### **OVERVIEW**

As part of several programs developed for Interns, AIA Richmond coordinates a series of lunchtime hard hat tours of different projects under construction within a 20-mile radius of downtown Richmond. The tours will be arranged in advance with the local architecture firm of record, and shall be offered to all intern architects free of charge. It is the desired goal of the tours program to expose interns to varying job site conditions, construction means and methods, and to introduce them to general construction administration issues.

Participants will be given a waiver of liability to complete (signed and dated) prior to job site visits (see attachment), and must adhere to general job site safety provisions. Participants are to provide their own safety equipment (hard hat, goggles, and closed-toed shoes) to be worn during the tours. Interns may document each one-hour hard hat tour accordingly to satisfy IDP training unit requirements.
